We welcome you to Ghana in style with a night of good music and cocktails at the Select Hotel.








### Day 2 **Accra City Tour**

Wear light airy clothing, sunscreen and comfortable shoes for this tour.





The festival features a festive celebration of Ghanaian culture in the form of Art & Fashion Installations, Live painting, The Best of African Cuisine and Live performances.







Wear light airy clothing, sunscreen and comfortable walking shoes/sneakers for this tour.














### Day 4 Cape Coast Castle

Wear light airy clothing, sunscreen and comfortable walking shoes/sneakers for this tour.



Light, airy clothing, swimwear, sunscreen, sunglasses and hats. Pack change of clothing (optional).


